

**Editorial Focuses:**

- Last-Minute Valentines: Quick and easy mini Valentines-these cards should be no larger than 3 x 3 inches; these can be shaped cards as well.
- Hopping Down the Bunny Trail: We're looking for Easter cards featuring bunny motifs. We'd like to showcase a wide variety of card styles from fun, whimsical designs to elegant, Victorian-style cards.

#### Summer 2014 Issue:

**Editorial Focuses:** 

- Graduation: cards appropriate for graduates of all ages. Wedding Day: shower and wedding invitations, thank you cards, cards for the bride and groom, anniversary cards.
- Patriotic Colors Feature: all-occasion cards for various life events; designs created with your favorite red, white and blue paper collection.
- All-Occasion Summer Cards: projects for various life events; design must include elements and colors reflecting sunny summer days.

#### Autumn 2014 Issue:

**Editorial Focuses:**

**Editorial Focuses:** Thanksgiving/Thank You Cards: designs should include an element of texture created with items such as burlap, textured paper or embossed cardstock. Veterans Day: Let's take the opportunity to remember and thank those who have served in any branch of the U.S. armed forces. All-Occasion Winter Cards: cards for various life events; sympathy, baby, thinking of you, get well, birthday.

- Happy Holidays!: clean and simple holiday cards.
- New Year's Celebrations: These cards can be party invitations or greeting cards to welcome the New Year.



Annie's operates on a Mac platform. Files must include ALL original files, images (linked, placed or supporting EPS files) and fonts.


#### Fonts
