



Design Theme: Spring Fling-Embellishments and Stow & Go Knits Explore inventive ways to add embellishment and edgings to create enticing texture

Compact projects, such as accessories, are great for traveling as the months start to warm up. Let's make life a little easier with quick-knit projects that are easy to stow and go!

Summer 2014

Design Theme: Sock-Weight Scarves & Ethereal Openwork

The idea of summer knitting evokes thoughts of simple designs using lightweight yarns and stitch patterns with impact. Pair up a large needle with a lightweight yarn to effortlessly create the natural look of openwork and mesh effects in your designs. Look for yarns that speak volumes so simple stitches can do all the work.

Autumn 2014

Design Theme: Refresh & Renew–Jump-Start Your Knitting Repertoire! Early fall is a transitional time when knitters are gearing up to start some early gift-

giving projects. This time serves as a perfect bridge for those garments and accessories that are created with both seasons in mind. Consider working with wool-blend yarns that include cotton and linen, which are practical choices that help extend your wardrobe into the cooler months ahead.

Winter 2014

Design Theme: Winter Whites, Happy Holiday Blues Everyone loves a knitted gift, so we're keeping things simple with a showcase of caps, cowls and a variety of easy cover-ups. Fingerless mitts are always on the top of the project list during the busy holidays, and your recipients will love them.




