

2023 EDITORIAL CALENDAR

SPRING 2023

SUBMISSION DUE DATE: 3/18/2022 ON-SALE DATE: 12/27/2022

- Easy Breezy: Light and lovely designs inspired by soft spring blooms. This section will feature movement and incredible drape with soft throws, light shawls and loose tops.
- Fun & Fanciful: Whimsical designs with a spring cottage feel. There should be bags, colorful wall hangings, amigurumi projects, and designs for kids and babies.
- Popular Patterns: New takes on those old favorites. Stylish pieces featuring updated granny stitch and granny square designs, with a mixture of vintage-feeling patterns and fresh colorways.

SUMMER 2023

SUBMISSION DUE DATE: 6/01/2022 ON-SALE DATE: 3/28/2023

- Road Trip: This should be filled with things that are necessary for a road trip cardigans, a sleep mask, a bag to hold snacks, pillows, vests with pockets, etc.
- Carnival Days: Fun and light! Think about what you would want to have or wear at a summer fair or carnival. These projects should be brightly colored and eye-catching, with stripes and fringe and checkers.

 Go Green: Eco-friendly projects that you can reuse, made with reused materials. Recycled yarns, T-shirt yarns, plarn, cotton, wool, lyocell (not bamboo), etc. crocheted into make-up removers, washcloths, drink bottle cozies and rugs.

AUTUMN 2023

SUBMISSION DUE DATE: 9/02/2022 ON-SALE DATE: 6/27/2023

- Spiced Stitches: The jasmine stitch as a star anise, treble cluster stitches that look like green cardamom pods, bobbles that look like nutmeg seeds, and "coffee" bean stitches should be spotlighted in the designs. Projects use shades of brown, green, saffron and ginger.
- Cool Nights: Inspired by bonfires on chilly nights. These projects feature darker colors and are oversize. They're meant to be cozy and comforting.
- Sweater Weather: This one is all about being warm on chilly days. Think sweaters and cardigans with solid colors, stripes, Fair Isle, cables, etc.

WINTER 2023


SUBMISSION DUE DATE: 12/06/2022 ON-SALE DATE: 9/26/2023

- Snow-Covered Cabin: This section is cozy and comfortable, and filled with pillows and blankets. We're looking for projects you would want in a winter getaway.
- **First Frost:** Whites, grays, greens and blues make up warm sweaters, scarves, hats, shawls, ponchos and ruanas. Mimic the frost with haloed yarn!
- Northern Lights: Dark blues, greens, pinks and glow-in-the-dark colors with swirling hues in projects you want to have on a cold winter night out.

SPRING 2024

SUBMISSION DUE DATE: 03/10/2023 ON-SALE DATE: 12/26/2023

- Sweet Shop: This section is all about sweet projects in sweet colors, with movement and soft edges. "Whipped cream" whites, "macaron" pastels, pale "milk tea" browns and "croissant" tans used for light sweaters, thin cardigans and hats that are all worked in the round.
- Watercolor Wonderland: Designs made with a lot of movement and soft yarn. This section should be filled with projects made with variegated, heathered and ombré yarns.
- **Sunday Morning:** Easy and Beginner patterns in neutral tones.
