# 2024 EDITORIAL CALENDAR\*

## SPRING 2024

#### SUBMISSIONS DUE DATE: 4/19/2023 ON-SALE DATE: 1/30/2024

- Spring Cleaning: Time to let our craft help us with the dirty work of spring cleaning! Create unique dishcloths and towels in lovely spring colors. Think beyond the typical as well and make designs for scrubbies, dust mitts, reusable wet mop pads, blind cleaners or aprons.
- Scrap Afghans: While we are spring cleaning, let's look for ways to tidy up the stash. In this chapter, we'll combine scraps to create afghans, throws, lapghans and baby blankets that are colorful and unique.
- Sweet Shop: This section will include whimsical designs and colors with a nod to sweet treats, like whipped cream, macarons and cakes. Translate those themes into light sweaters, cardigans, adorable mug rugs or cozies, or cute amigurumi designs.
- Watercolor Wonderland: Variegated or ombré yarns in soft hues with great drape will come together in this section to create beautiful tops, bags or accessories. These items will also make great Mother's Day presents with pretty colors and interesting stitch patterns.

## SUMMER 2024

#### SUBMISSIONS DUE DATE: 7/19/2023 ON-SALE DATE: 4/30/2024

- One-Skein Wonders: What can you make from just one put-up of yarn? This section will include useful and practical items for your home, like dishcloths; coasters; mug rugs; mug, can or to-go cup cozies; storage containers; etc. Small wearables fit in this category as well.
- Waterfront Living: The heat of summer is on and we're channeling the cool vibes of the lake, ocean or pool into designs such as home decor pieces that reflect these aesthetics as well as cover-ups, airy cardigans and sun hats that can be worn to the beach or the pool. This section will also include picnic-style items like cozies, outdoor pillows, picnic blankets, cup covers (to keep those pesky bugs out of our treats) and more.
- Summer Garden: Flowers, fruits and vegetables are the inspiration behind the designs in this chapter, which will include home decor pieces, wearables and cute amigurumi projects. Bright colors, floral motifs and colorwork are great ways to express the beauty of nature in your designs.

### AUTUMN 2024

### SUBMISSIONS DUE DATE: 10/25/2023 ON-SALE DATE: 8/6/2024

- Harvest Home: This section will include projects embellished with or mimicking pumpkins, gourds or leaves as well as designs that conjure up the feeling of autumn with warm fall color combinations. We are looking for afghans, table settings, kitchen items and whimsical projects that bring the beauty of autumn inside.
- Toasty Feet: Keep your toes toasty-warm as the cool weather sneaks back in with slippers and booties. We are looking for coverings for your feet for this chapter slippers, booties and socks in thick or thin styles for everyone in the family.
- Rustic Charm: Shades of brown and jewel tones are used in warm sweaters, cardigans, ponchos and ruanas for this chapter.
  Accessories that reflect rustic charm and natural fibers to keep you warm and toasty as the temps drop would also be perfect.
  Think about yarns that are made from natural fibers or rustic toothy wools that will give the stitches texture and depth.

### WINTER 2024

### SUBMISSIONS DUE DATE: 1/29/2024 ON-SALE DATE: 11/5/2024

- Stocking Stuffers: 'Tis the season where stockings will be hung and gifts will abound. The key here is small, fun projects: little stuffies or fidget toys for the kids, small home decor items, small pouches for earbuds or lip balm, mug cozies, gift-card holders, scrubbies, bookmarks, lanyards for your keys, etc. Think small and scrappy!
- Home for the Holidays: Embrace all the holidays that take place this time of year as you think of designs to celebrate the season. Doilies, seat mats or covers, table runners, place mats, coasters, baskets and bowls with a holiday theme or in holiday colors are all a great fit for this chapter.
- Under the Tree: This one is all about gifts! The section will include projects that anyone would love to receive, like scarves, hats, shawls, throw blankets, cup cozies, amigurumi designs, baskets and more!
- Snow & Sunshine: Snowy, wintry whites and creams will fill the projects in this section. The projects should be squishy and light with plenty of movement. Think about how to bring a wintry feel or snowflakes into your designs. There will be sweaters, cardigans, ponchos and shawls as well as fun pieces for the home, such as snow-themed amigurumi projects, afghans, place mats, rugs and more.

### SPRING 2025

### SUBMISSIONS DUE DATE: 4/17/2024 ON-SALE DATE: 1/28/2025

- Thick & Quick: Fight off the last of the winter chill with projects that use bulky- to super bulky-weight yarns. These projects will be thick, warm and cozy. Afghans, throws, wraps, cowls, slippers, squishy rugs and cardigans would be amazing in heavyweight yarns.
- Love Is in the Air: Embrace Valentine's Day in all its heart-shaped glory! Home decor designs that feature hearts or are heart-shaped are the focus. Use your creativity and scatter hearts on any number of projects using any number of techniques. Think about projects for every room in the house.
- Wildflower Fields: This chapter will feature creative specialty stitches that make designs inspired by spring flowers. Translate these into lovely tops, open cardigans, table runners, afghans, baskets, doilies or coasters in lovely spring colors.
- Oh Baby!: Let's wrap that little one in love with projects designed especially with babies in mind—small, soft blankets, cocoons, little hats and booties, keepsake pieces, and tiny sweaters or toys (that are safe for babies). Baby showers are a constant in many lives, and projects that would make great gifts would also be ideal for this section.
